

Naviance Student Summer Assignment

In support of your dreams of attending college, the following assignment will make the Fall semester of your senior year less overwhelming. Research demonstrates that students who have a college list before entering their senior year, are more prepared and less stressed. If your plans involve something other than attending a 2 or 4 year college complete Part III of this assignment.

Part I

1. Log into your [Naviance Student Account](#) - **username** is your 9-digit student ID number; if you've never changed your password, the default password is "naviance" (all lower-case, no quotation marks). If you forgot your password, use the "Forgot your password?" link to reset your password. If you get locked out of your account, please email flhs5820@gmail.com - be sure to include your full legal name and 9-digit student ID number and an email will be sent to you with your reset information.
2. As a follow up to your Spring class visit in the College & Career Center, using Naviance, research and build your college list by clicking on **Colleges > Find Your Fit > SuperMatch**
3. Choose at the minimum the following 3 Fit Criteria:
 - a. Location
 - b. Academics
 - c. Admission
 - i. Find your most recent Weighted GPA on **Naviance**: About Me > My Account and enter it here:
 - ii. Your SAT/ACT scores are pre-populated - if they're not, check your **College Board** or **ACT Student** accounts for your latest scores. Enter your SAT/ACT here:
4. From the list generated from your SuperMatch search, decide which colleges you will apply to, and add them to your "COLLEGES I'm applying to" list in Naviance. **Complete the CUNY, SUNY, and Private colleges tables below to submit to your English teacher. We suggest a list of no more than 6 CUNY colleges, 6 SUNY colleges, 8 private/out-of-state colleges, or any combination for a maximum of 20 colleges. On average, our students apply to 10 – 12 colleges. Creating this list in the summer will prepare you for your Fall senior college appointment where you can discuss Reach, Target, Safety, and any other concerns with your college counselor.**

Opportunity Programs (SEEK/CD, EOP, HEOP): Opportunity Programs provide access, academic support, and financial aid to students who show promise for succeeding in college but who may not otherwise be offered admission. Students must meet the following eligibility requirements:
(1) be a New York State resident for 12 months prior to enrollment,
(2) qualify as economically disadvantaged based on the income guidelines on Table 1, and
(3) qualify as educationally disadvantaged – student who would not be accepted under colleges' general admissions standards.
